



# Community Update

Vista Gold invites members of the community to comment on its draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Mt Todd Gold Project.

The project proposes to re-establish, operate and rehabilitate the Mt Todd Gold Mine approximately 55km north-west of Katherine and 250km south of Darwin.

The draft EIS was prepared by independent consultants GHD Pty Ltd to support key Commonwealth and Northern Territory Government approvals under the Commonwealth *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* and the *Northern Territory Environmental Assessment Act 1982*.

Vista Gold welcomes the opportunity to clarify environmental aspects of the project through this process and we are looking forward to working together with the Government and the community to take this project forward.

We are encouraged by the

potential of the Mt Todd gold project and have consulted with a wide range of representatives from community, non-government groups and key organisations since January 2011 to ensure that we have a full appreciation of the range of factors involved.

Community input is an important part of the EIS as it assists in identifying potential environmental, social, transport, cultural and economic impacts associated with reopening and operating the Mt Todd Gold Mine.

The draft EIS is available on the NTEPA and Mt Todd websites and will be on public display from 28 June until 12 August 2013.

Interested parties wishing to comment on the draft EIS are invited to make written submissions on or before 12 August 2013.
